Reading Books KS2

Reading Books KS1 and EYFS

For KS1 and EYFS pupils (Class 1 and 2), who are completing remote learning at home, are invited to visit the school office during your daily exercise on Monday 25th to change over your child/children's home reading books.

On arrival Miss Reynolds or Mrs Waters will come down to the office to change over your child's book following their assessed reading band colour. We will ensure all COVID safety measures are in place during these book exchanges also. Please form a 2m distanced queue outside the main office, leaving the slop and gate entrance clear for parents enabling them to also leave the office following the 2m distancing safety guidance. (Only one family in the office at a time please).
