Once in Africa, they are distributed to workshops, training centres, churches, schools, and individuals in need. The items are used to teach a trade so that people are able to support themselves and their families.

When they have completed the training they are each given the necessary tools to be able to earn a living. It could be a mechanics tool kit, carpenters tool kit, sewing machine and sewing kit, knitting machine and knitting kit or gardening items for example.
