We have been:

- Creating gifts for the special women in our families for Mother's Day

In Phonics we have been:

- Learning the new digraphs 'or' and 'ow' (a digraph is 2 letters that make 1 sound)
- Learning the new tricky word 'a'. As a phoneme this makes the short sound 'a', but as a word in a sentence e.g. 'I bought a hat' it is pronounced as it's letter name 'a' (ai/ae/ay) which is why it's a tricky word!

In Maths we have been:

- Ordering different items by their length. We have been using measuring tape, rulers and metre sticks to measure different lengths and have also been measuring ourselves! We have also talked about how we can use different things to measure too, for example our hands and our feet. See what you can measure with your hands at home!
