## Covid Reminders

Dear Parent and Carers,

As national restrictions continue to be lifted across the country, it is still important that we all continue to follow measures in place when a child or adult displays symptoms of Covid to limit any future transmission.

**No child should come to school if they, or anyone they live with, has one or more of the Covid-19 symptoms.** These are:

- A new persistent cough
- A high temperature
- A change in their normal sense of taste or smell.

If a child or adult has any of these symptoms they need to be tested at a **Test Centre**. This is different from the Lateral Flow Tests that you may have at home.

Please ensure that you contact the school **immediately** to inform us if your child or a member of your household becomes unwell and requires a Covid-19 test, or if you are advised to self-isolate or have the outcome of tests. Please leave a message on the school answerphone if this is before or after school hours. Children who are required to isolate at home can continue to work using their eSchools account.
