SCARF - Valuing Differences

We will identify similarities and differences, learn how to empathise with those who are different from ourselves and appreciate the positive aspects of those differences. We will consider the difference between being unkind, teasing and bullying and understand that bullying is quite rare. We will be able to explain the school rules and how these help to keep us safe. We will also think about our special people and recognise what qualities they have that make them special. We will explore what is fair / unfair, kind / unkind and consider different ways that we can show kindness to others.

We will classify different animals as omnivores, carnivores or herbivores.

We will learn dance with Mrs. Coleman and games skills with Mr. Gabaldoni.

As historians...

We will find out about the life and times of Guy Fawkes by researching using the internet and books. We will celebrate Remembrance Day and investigate Angus Buchanan, why he is important to Coleford and what he did to make the lives of people better.
