There will be a statutory multiplication tables check in June 2022. Your child is expected to be fluent in the rapid recall of all multiplication facts. Please support your child (at home) and help them learn their tables. This needs to be out of order, rather than recalling multiples, e.g. $4 \times 3 = 12$, $4 \times 7 = 28$, $4 \times 2 = 8$
