## Here's how it works...

The challenge video will be released on on the first day of each challenge. Parents will need to submit scores to their child's school within the challenge timeframe.

Children at home, or those who have returned to school can take part in the age appropriate challenge.

Schools will need to add up the total number of points and send this total, along with the number of entries to their SGO by 2pm on the last day of the challenge (see dates above).

Results from each district will go to the county School Games team and winners will be announced the day after the challenge ends (Friday).

Winners will be announced via social media and SGOs. We will award gold, silver and bronze for winning schools and also for schools who had the highest percentage of participants (we will work this out based on the number of children in your school to make it fair for all school sizes).

SGOs will email you specific details about each challenge, including the photography competition and virtual festival.
