



### PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

### LITERACY

- Participating in Read, Write, Inc sessions to segment the sounds in simple words and blend them together. Reading words and simple sentences and understanding what they have read.
- Writing simple captions and sentences which can be read by themselves and others.
- Learning that some words are spelt correctly and others are phonetically plausible.



### COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

- Listening to stories, accurately anticipating key events and responding to what they hear with relevant comments, questions or actions.
- Answering how and why questions about their experiences and responding to stories and events.
- Using Oracy techniques to talk clearly and in extended sentences.
