Marvellous Me and Settling In Messages

Thank you very much to everyone who has already signed up for Marvellous Me! We hope that you are enjoying the messages that are coming out from class. If you have not yet accessed your child's account, please do download the app or visit the Marvellous Me website and log in with your child's password.

As per the text message that went out earlier this week, we have had feedback from some parents suggesting that you log into the website online first if you are having any difficulty in logging in for the first time on the app. This seems to be a good workaround.

Between Monday 19th October and Thursday 22nd October, all class teachers will be using Marvellous Me to send out short, individual 'settling in report' messages to all children. You will need to access your child's account in order to see this. Messages will come out over this period of time, rather than all in one go, as teachers will need to create and post them individually.

If, when you have read your child's settling in message, you would like to discuss it further, please do contact us using the key stage emails (please refer to the school newsletter for details of the addresses) and we will respond as soon as we can.

We hope that you are finding Marvellous Me easy to use and a good way to find out more about what the children are up to in school. We are hoping to develop our use of Marvellous Me over the next few terms and would love all children in school to have at least one adult signed up to view their account. Please note that each child's account can have numerous adults signed up to it so wider family can share your child's good news from school if you would like them to.
