Bubble of Closure

Thank you very much for your patience and understanding this morning as we made the decision to close Miss Miche's classroom bubble following the advice from Public Health England. As we communicated on the phone, this is a precautionary measure due to a child displaying some Covid-19 symptoms in the classroom this morning. We will regularly update you as and when we get further information and will re-open the bubble as soon as it is safe to do so. We will ensure that a deep clean takes place in the class bubble before the children's return.

There is no requirement for other pupils or staff within the school to isolate at this time. Members of the household do not need to isolate unless any member of the family develops symptoms of Covid-19.

All children have their home learning packs that we sent home prior to half term. Please work through this initially and we will work to ensure that further work is sent out as needed. We would like to use Marvellous Me as our main method of communication and, as a result, if you have not logged into the system, please do phone the school and we will help you to do so.

In addition, we will be in contact with any family entitled to benefits-related Free School Meals (not Universal Free School Meals) to arrange the collection of a food parcel in place of school lunches.

As ever I assure you that the safety and wellbeing of children and staff is our highest priority and I will remain in touch with you throughout this period of closure.
