Good morning Tregolls families!

I hope you have had a lovely summer holiday and your children ready and refreshed for the autumn term.

The first day of school this term for children in years 1 – 6 is Friday 3rd September. Gates will be open at 8.35 and doors open at 8.45. Children will be going in specific doors for the class they are in:

Yr 1 Fal and Yr 1 Mylor in the Key Stage 1 playground class doors, round the back of the school.

Yr 2 Camel and Helford the New Hall doors.

Yr 3/4 Ottery, 3/4 Truro and Yr 3/4 Cober the gable end door round the back of the school.

Fowey Yr 6, Lerryn Yr 5/6 and Tamar Yr 5 the automatic double doors.

We expect all children to be in school at 8.45 promptly, late arrivals will be monitored and if your child is late more than once we will be in touch to see how we can support you to arrive on time. If they continue to be late then we will ask the Educational Welfare Officer to get involved to support you further. It is so important for children to start the day on time, with their friends...coming in late is never a nice start for them. We thank you for your support in making this happen.

Please remember it is full school uniform now and we expect all children to be in uniform from Friday. No leggings, suitable black school shoes or plain black trainers with NO logo, jade or navy sweatshirt, jade or navy polo top, navy trousers or skirt and no summer dresses in the autumn term. We also ask that children wear PE kit to school on the days they have PE (you will be told this in your class letters). We can't wait to see your lovely children walking into school looking smart and ready for the term!

As we told you before the end of last term, many of the Covid measures in place in school have been dropped, as instructed by the government. We now have no "bubbles" or staggered starts and children will have lunches in the halls with their year groups. We continue to follow strict hygiene routines to stop the spread of infection and we ventilate classrooms at all times. We have also decided not to have large assemblies this term or invite parents into school for performances, parents evening etc. I am sure you are as aware as we are of the high rate of infections in Cornwall at the moment and we remain cautious. I want to reassure you, that even though we all wish to be

back to normal, we are being very careful and are not behaving like Covid has gone away. My priority remains to keep children and staff safe, however I do need to follow government legislation.

A reminder that the government's "step 4" isolation rules mean that if a member of your household has Covid other members of the household do not need to self-isolate if they have been double jabbed, or they are under 18. This means if you or a member of your family has Covid your child can come to school. However, if ANYONE, including children, have symptoms of Covid 19 they must stay at home and get a PCR test and can only return to school with a negative result. The main symptoms of Covid are: high temperature, continuous new cough, loss of taste and smell.

Above all else, we can't wait to see your children and get on with the new school year! The teachers are all here busy training and preparing. As much as we know we have to deal with Covid and it will impact on things such as Christmas and Harvest, we will try and make things as normal as we safely can.
