WHOLE SCHOOL COLLECTIVE WORSHIP DURING COVID

Although, due to Covid restrictions, we are currently unable to physically bring the whole school together, into one space at church or in school. We are still able to carry out an act of collective worship each day.

We use a range of resources to do so, including recorded PowerPoints, videos and Microsoft Teams.

Throughout the week before lunch each class can access the pre-recorded collective worship resource uploaded by our headteacher or by the vicar. Each class lights their own candle to remind them that, Jesus is the light of the world, and takes time to think about the teachings of Jesus and about current events and issues.

Our vicar Reverend David Harris also provides us with bible readings on a Wednesday via his own YouTube channel. On Thursdays we have class assemblies which often lead into quizzes, poetry or artwork and are led by our class teachers. On Fridays, we meet up via Teams for our whole school Celebration Assembly.

Each half term we select one of our school's Christian values and it is used as a theme across our collective worship and is also included in our PHSE lessons. You will be able to see our Christian values display in the main corridor as you enter our school.
