

Ashfield Nursery School Action Early Years Pupil Premium Plan - September 2020-21

From April 2015 we were able to claim extra Government funding for some of our 3 and 4 year olds in the Nursery school to support their development, learning and care. This funding is called the Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP).

The Early Years Pupil Premium provides us with an extra 53pence per hour for 3&4 year old children whose parents are in receipt of certain benefits or who have been in care or adopted from care. This means an extra £302 per year for each child taking up the full 15 hours per week funded entitlement to early education. It is well known that high quality early education can influence how well a child does both in primary and secondary school so we do want to make the most of the additional funding

Across the year we expect on average approximately 50 children eligible for Early Years Pupil Premium.

We expect to receive approximately £15,000 this academic year

We again plan to provide an additional hour twice each week in a nurture group for each of our children who qualify for EYPP. We are also offering this opportunity to all of the children in nursery as we feel that the particularly low level of baseline attainment this September could be due to the time many children had absent from nursery during the first lockdown in the Spring 2020. The activities that staff will focus on will support our desired outcomes – see below.
