Child's expectations for lockdown/year group closure

- Daily English and Maths activities will be posted on the website and on the link for this will be added to Seesaw

- If you want your child's teacher to comment on their learning on the same day, please post it before 3.30pm otherwise you may have to wait until the following day

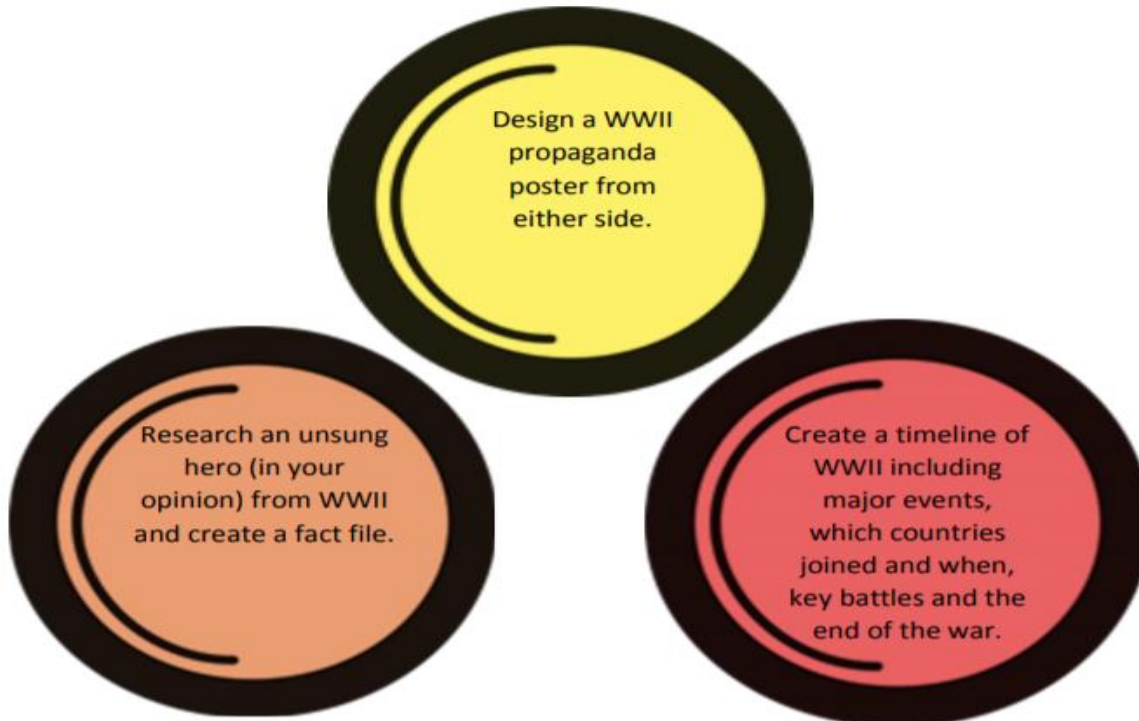
