

HUMANITIES

We are exploring Invaders and Settlers, with a focus on the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings, and answering the question "Were the Vikings really that vicious?" We will focus on historical skills such as reliability of sources and our key concept of *continuity and change* through the invasions and settlements that took place during this period of history.



MATHS

We will be building on fluency, reasoning and problem-solving skills, while focusing on place value, negative numbers and addition and subtraction. Once secure in these, we will move onto statistics and then multiplication and division, where we will look at formal written methods.



SCIENCE

We are focusing on planning different types of scientific enquiries to answer questions. We will use the results to make further predictions and to set up more tests. We will report and present findings from our tests using speaking and written results. Our topics will be Properties & Changes to Materials and Forces.



ENGLISH

Our English work throughout the first half term will be based on our class novel, *Riddle of the Runes*. We will use it to look at word types, sentence structure, language techniques and building a narrative based on a character solving a mystery. We will continue to work on key spelling patterns and our joined handwriting.
