Dear Parents/Carers,

Following the North Warwickshire Borough Council High Covid case alert for our area, please could I remind you that we are still in lockdown and therefore the following should NOT be happening:

- Children visiting other family homes
- Sleepovers
- Children from different households playing together outside of school

Please adhere to the guidelines so that you are not putting adults and children in school at risk.

As we are in the high alert area, I would also urge you to collect or order Lateral Flow Devices (which are plastic cartridge home test kits) and test regularly particularly if anyone in the family is displaying any of the wider symptoms such as cold like symptoms, sore throat, severe fatigue, headaches, muscle aches or upset stomach.

If anyone in the household has any of the main three Covid symptoms (new or worsening cough, high temperature and loss or change in taste or smell) please ensure that you arrange for a PCR test either via the post or at a local test centre. The household must self-isolate for 10 days from the date of first symptoms unless there is a negative PCR test result.
