


Heswall Primary Spring Survey 2018

What class is your child in?






Approximately 93% of parents stated that their child feels safe in school.

My child is making good progress.





My child is taught well in this school.



There is a good standard of behaviour in this school.






A large majority of 89% of parents feel that the school is improving.




A large majority of 89.2% of parents feel welcome in the school.




A large majority of 96% of parents would recommend this school to other parents.

One of the school's strengths is the way it nurtures the children?





Do you look at the school website?



Most parents regularly look at the website. 43.5% visit it at least once a week. A small minority of 2.2% have never visited the school website.


A question about the eSchools app that we are using to keep you more informed about school.

How would you prefer us to send information e.g. newsletters to you? (we currently use all methods)



Do you look at the school Twitter feed either on Twitter or via the school website?


92 responses

Do you feel that the school communicates effectively with parents?



What is your child's favourite area of learning?



This school offers a good range of extra curricular activities e.g. yoga clubs, football and handicraft etc? 



I value the school's enrichment activities e.g. special theme days such as World Book Day, Sports Relief, Rainforest Rainshows, visits from school theatres and lots of other events.



I am pleased to be able to say, "My child goes to Heswall Primary."



For emergency health reasons, if we were to ban peanuts and products containing peanuts due to a very severe and life threatening allergy, would you support this?


83 responses
