# Assessment

EYFS = 7 areas of learning, broken into 3 prime areas and 4 specific areas. Underpinning these are 3 effective characteristics of learning. The children need to achieve the prime areas in order to be successful in the specific ones. Each area is broken down further into early learning goals.

Tapestry - electronic learning journey. You will be able to access this and see where your child is in these areas and add your own evidence too.

Your child will come home this week with a username and password to access:

Reading Eggs - supports reading and development

Purple Mash - supports all areas of the curriculum

We will also let you know this week how you can access the school library.

Continue to read and enjoy stories and nursery rhymes at home, we will begin RWInc this week. When the children are secure in all the initial sounds and can blend, they will then move onto a coloured book which they will be able to bring home and successfully read.
