## YEAR 4 AYLVERTON RESIDENTIAL – Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> September-Friday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2020

We have made a provisional booking to take next year's Year 4 children (current Year 3's) on a residential visit to Aylmerton Field Study Centre, Norfolk, at the beginning of September 2020. We are aware that this seems an unusual time to be going on residential, but the centre are able to offer us a reduced price for these dates. This will be our fifth trip to Aylmerton from Woodstone. It is a fantastic trip as it offers something different from the norm. Digging for fossils on the beach, walking barefoot in the mud and midnight expeditions looking for bats with an echolocator are not the usual type of activities for a residential visit.

We will be holding a parents meeting on **Monday 18<sup>th</sup> November at 6:00pm**, and will require a non-refundable initial deposit of £10 per child by **Monday 25<sup>th</sup> November** please. This should be paid on school money as per usual. We will then require an additional holding deposit of £50 per child, payable by **Friday 20<sup>th</sup> December** at the latest.

The children will leave at 7.00am on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> September and return at approximately 5:00pm on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> September (depending on traffic!)

We will be taking four of our own staff and there will also be at least one member of staff from Aylmerton accompanying our group whilst we are there.

We will be staying at the Aylmerton Field Study Centre, Aylmerton, Norfolk, NR11 8RA.

The full cost of the trip is £200, based on all of the children going, which includes all of the centre activities, including two off site visits, food and coach transport to and from the centre and whilst we are there. Please be aware that should some parents choose not to send their children on the trip, the cost will increase by a few pounds.

The trip is always a fantastic adventure, which the children really enjoy.
