Donations:

To make our bulb planting a success we need some donations:

Large tubs - which you no longer need. We are hoping to plant some bulbs in movable tubs to create lovely displays around school, as well as plant straight into the ground.

Compost/Top soil – we will purchase some, but if anyone has any to spare it will be gratefully received (ideally before by Wednesday 18th so we can see how much we have).

Bulbs – if you are able to donate a bag of bulbs we would be very grateful. (There will be a box by the Windmills gate for KS1 and a box by the Year 4/5 gate for KS2 donations from Monday morning onwards.)

If you are attending the bulb planting session on Friday, **please** bring along any gloves, trowels, wheelbarrows, forks or other equipment that may come in handy as we don't have a full class set.
