



Dear Parents and Carers,

Outdoor Learning: Rabbits A GROUP

We have arranged some outdoor learning sessions, which will take place across the year. These will be mainly Forest School but will also include some gardening or outdoor 'crafts'. Details of dates and times below.

Sessions will take place within school grounds or on the uncultivated land next to the school and adjacent to Hundred Acre Lane and will last all afternoon. This land can be accessed directly from the school so the children will not need to walk on the road. Each class will be divided into two, so 15/16 children at a time will have their Forest School sessions. The children remaining in school will be taught by myself. Unless the weather is exceptionally wet and windy, these sessions will not be cancelled.

On the day of your child's Forest School session, unless notified otherwise, your child should come to school in clothes ready for Forest School; however please ensure they have suitable indoor shoes for the rest of their lessons.

They will need to wear:

Old clothes

Sturdy shoes, or wellington boots if wet underfoot

Definitely no open toe sandals, however warm it is!

Dependent on weather:

Warm layers

Waterproof coat

Sun hat

Sun cream
