**What do you think digest/digestive system mean?**

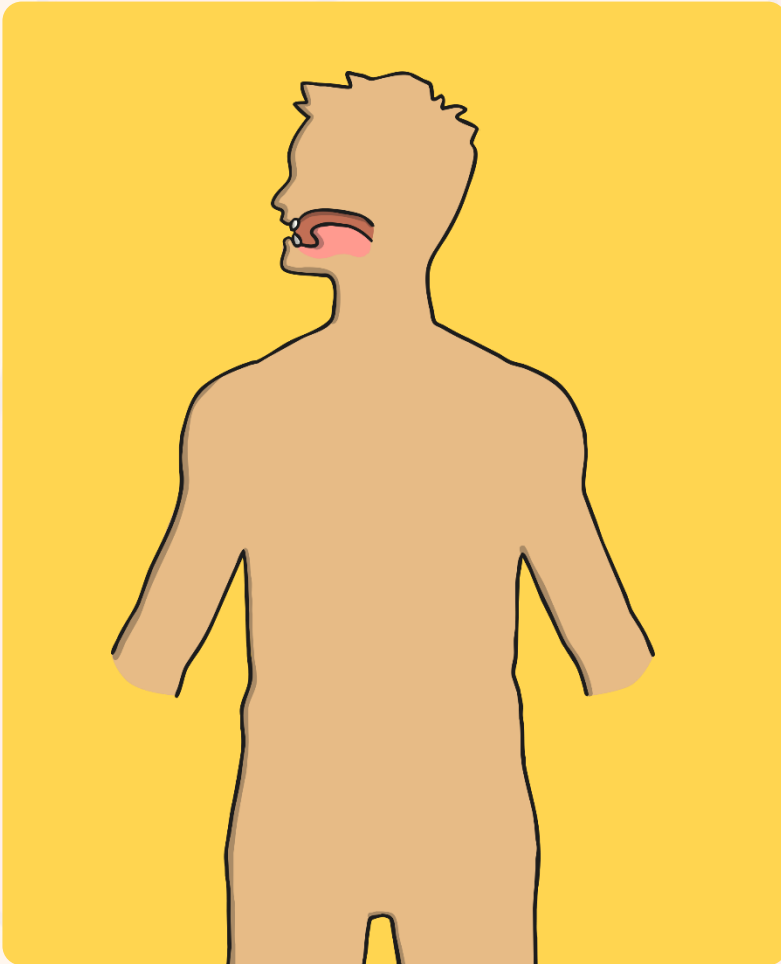
## Digest
