### Easter Holidays

#### **Free School Meals (FSM)**

We have made arrangements to continue free school meals over the Easter Holiday. A packed lunch 'take away' can be collected from the Junior school between 12 and 2 and on Good Friday and Bank Holiday Monday **from Twerton Infant school** .

This is for all families with children that are entitled to FSM but they will need to be COLLECTED. We are unable to staff delivery. Please text your order of choice of filling by 9:30 a.m (cheese, tuna, ham) ideally for the entire week. These packed lunch take aways will also continue after the Easter Holidays but you will need to make arrangements if you are shielding or isolating for someone to collect them on your behalf. We are unable to continue delivery.

The Government have stated that *'During these challenging times, we want to ensure that pupils eligible for free school meals can continue to access support if they are not in school. In the first instance, we are encouraging schools to provide meals or food parcels through their current food provider'*

Working with the Bath and Wells Trust and our catering provider (Edwards and Ward) we have managed to keep a hub kitchen open at our school that will deliver to all BWMAT local schools and the Infant school, therefore we do not need to issue vouchers at this time.

Please take advantage of your free school meal by collecting it at the times above but observe social distancing from other parents/ carers who may be also collecting lunches. We will text when we have extra food parcels or surplus food for you also to collect if you need.

#### **Supervision and site**

The school building is open for the supervision of a very small number of children but the office phone will not be staffed during this time. The site will be closed completely over the Bank Holiday weekend. Therefore please use the text and email service to contact us about FSM.

#### **Remote learning**

Teachers too will need a rest and so will not be setting daily learning through teams nor be online but the children can continue to connect with each other. There may be some optional suggestions for boredom busting activities or even a project. Children can also continue to complete learning previously set.

We wish all of you good health and happiness in the time you have to spend together and hope we can see you all soon. I would like to take this opportunity to again thank the staff team for volunteering for a range of jobs, giving up their holiday time and risking their own health and that of their families by providing a high level of support to the community both on and off site.

Thank you for your continued support, we will update you about plans from 20<sup>th</sup> April when they have been confirmed.
