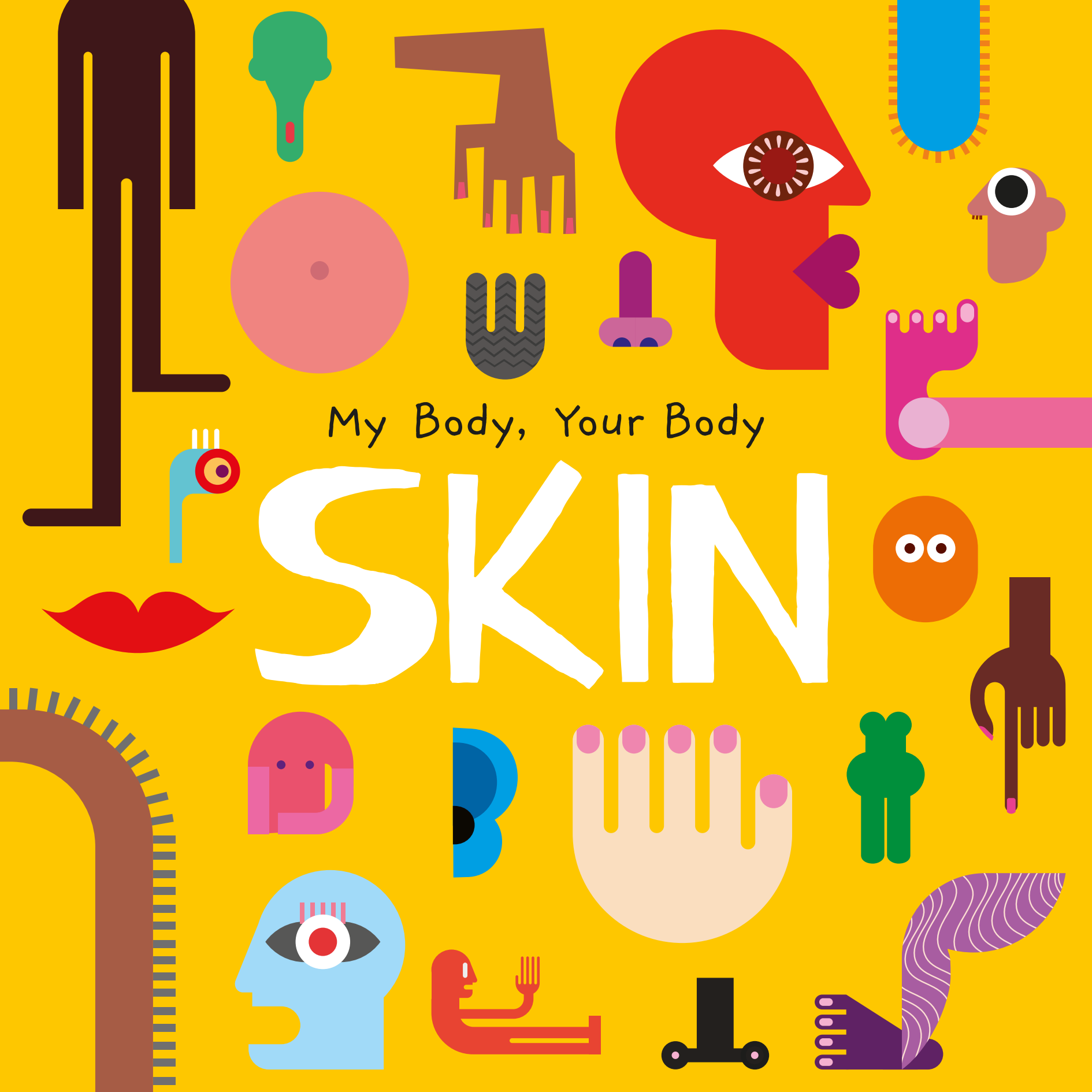
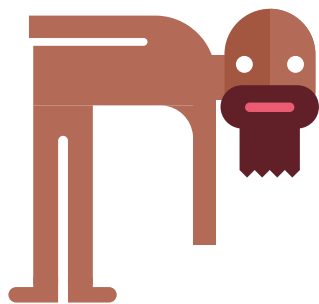

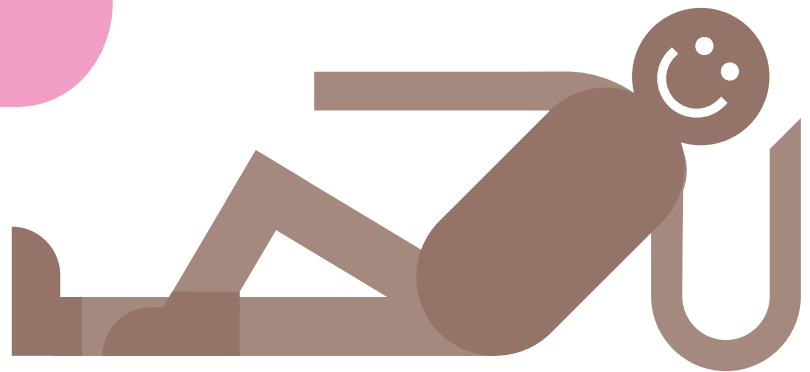

This skin is brown.



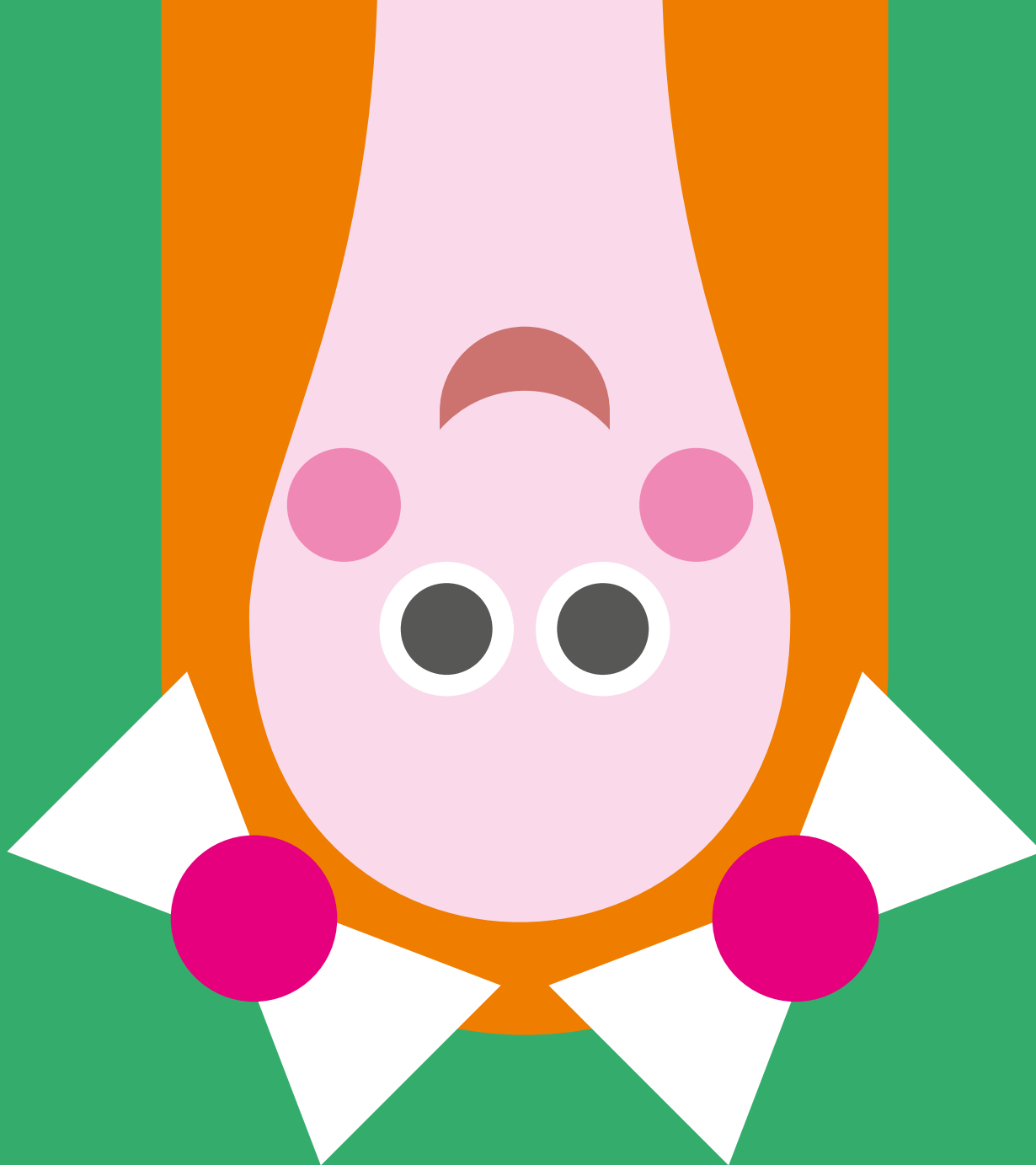
