Dear Parents and Carers,

I have been delighted with the effort, determination and perseverance of the children this week and it has been lovely seeing them get together for their class meets.

Here are some important updates for everyone:

Remote learning—please read the letter regarding our transition to using Microsoft Teams and Power Maths from Monday 25th January. This has been sent separately to all parents by email.

Free school meals vouchers—every eligible child (regardless of whether they are in school or not) will receive a £15 FSM voucher each week instead of food parcels. Emails will be sent to the relevant families.

The Bishops' Bike track—our Stage 2 grant application to British Cycling was submitted on Wednesday and has been accepted for assessment. This is the final hurdle and I am hoping we will hear soon.

Eden Project Outdoor Learning consultation—our teachers met online on Wednesday evening with the designer team from the Eden Project to finalise the consultation process. All the ideas will now be factored into a design brief which we can then use to attract funding and gain quotes from contractors.

Healthy Schools Award 2021-2023— we were informed this morning that our application to renew our status as a Healthy School was approved. The Healthy Schools team said: *We are delighted to let you know that our team of Healthy Schools Advisors have approved your submission. We are therefore able to confirm that you have achieved Healthy Schools Status for 2021 - 2023. This recognises the hard work and dedication that you and your team have demonstrated in supporting the wellbeing of your school community. We are excited to work with you on your action plan over the next two years to enable you to achieve your next Healthy School Award in 2023. Congratulations! This award is thoroughly well deserved, and we are delighted about your success.*

This was a significant amount of work and I would like to thank Mrs Rule and Mrs Yeomans for organising all the evidence.

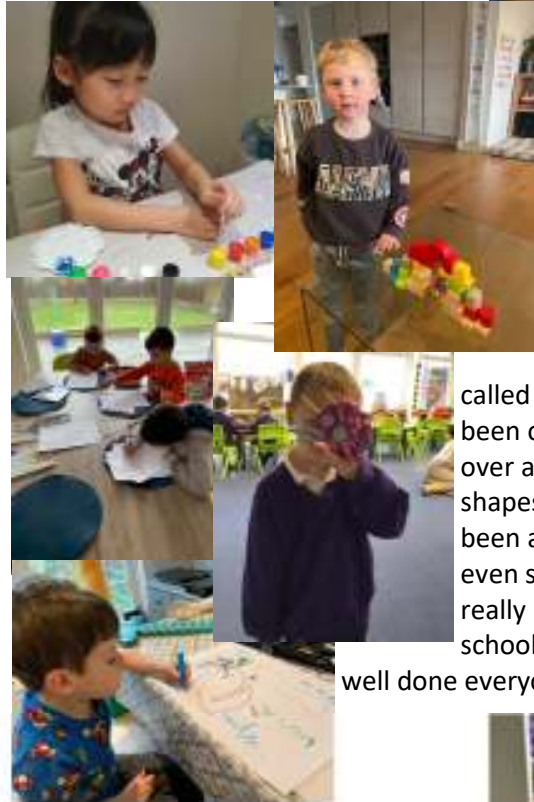

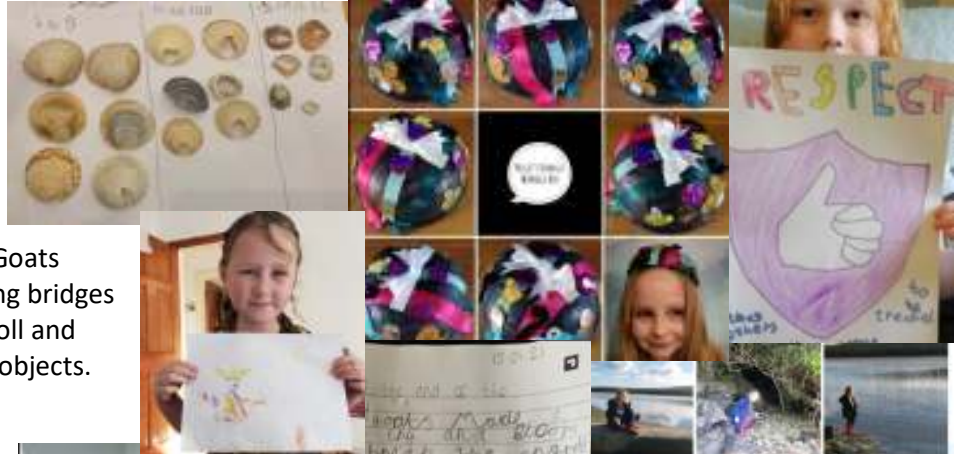
