Gerrans Horticultural Show

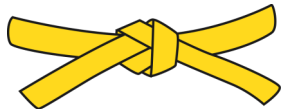

Congratulation to Daisy who won a cup for her poster and Imogen who won a cup for most points.

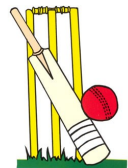
