

## Remote learning Protocol St George's School

In the event of a child/children being unable to attend school because of Covid-19, the following procedures will be followed:

Single child staying at home awaiting test result for themselves or a family member:

- Parents continue to support the child through normal homework activities e.g. Spelling practise, mental maths practise, reading, TT Rockstars & Mathletics etc.

Child or family member with positive test result resulting in self-isolation (well enough to work)

- Parent to contact school to advise of absence.
- Office staff will inform relevant class teacher of expected period of absence.
- Class teacher will communicate with the family to sign-post Microsoft Teams to access Home Learning.
- Class teacher to send information via email and Teams to find expectations for learning during expected period of absence.
- Class teacher to provide links to relevant websites for lessons and follow-up worksheets to cover the expected period of absence.

Child with positive test result (Not well enough to work)

- No work additional work set. Parents may support with normal homework tasks if they choose to..

Small contact group needing to self isolate after positive test result

- Parent to contact school to advise of absence.
- Office staff will inform relevant class teacher of expected period of absence.
- Class teacher will communicate with the family to sign-post Microsoft Teams to access Home Learning.
- Class teacher to send information via email and Teams to find expectations for learning during expected period of absence.
- Class teacher to provide links to relevant websites for lessons and follow-up worksheets to cover the expected period of absence.

Whole class "bubble" needing to self-isolate or whole school closure

- Class teacher will communicate via Microsoft Teams to inform parents of learning tasks for the week ahead
- Class teacher will provide links to relevant websites for lessons and follow-up tasks.
- Work will be set by the class teacher via Microsoft Teams to support learning in other curriculum areas weekly.
- Class teacher will be available daily between the hours of 9.00 and 3.15 to support children's learning via Microsoft Teams and class emails.
- Recorded sessions will be provided once a day via Microsoft Teams.

Remote learning will be communicated via Microsoft Teams Class Accounts and in the event of school or whole "Bubble" closure, on the school website.

Remote learning platforms will include:

- Mathletics
- TT Rockstars
- White Rose Maths
- Oxford Owl
- Oak National Academy
- BBC Bitesize

Follow-up tasks may include worksheets which can be completed online, printed and photographed or scanned and sent to the class teachers via email or Teams.

In special circumstances, parents may request a paper pack where there is limited access to computers or the internet at home.
