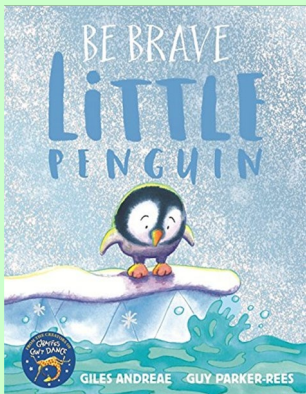


# Welcome to SPOKES!
