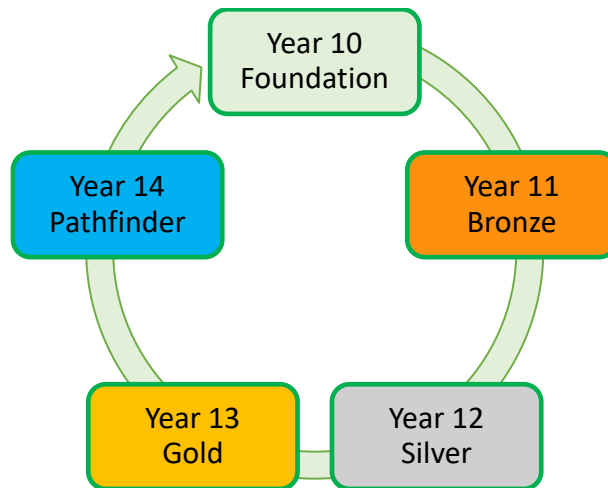


Post 14 Pathways and Accreditations Map

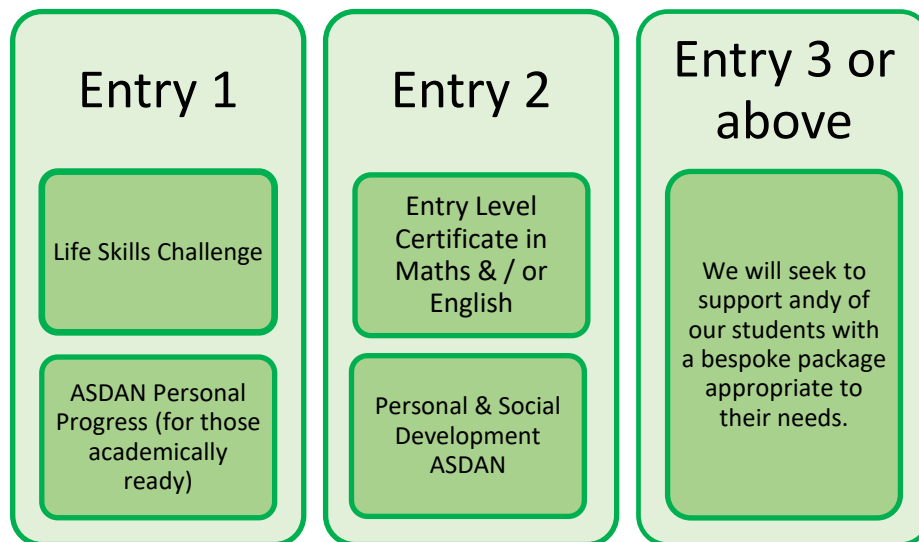


Our **Learning to Learn** students will work towards the [Pegasus Award](#). This is a bespoke, certificated programme linked to progress towards EHCP outcomes. Students will achieve a certificate indicating their progress for every year they remain at Doubletrees.



At Key Stage Four (Year 10 and 11) our Bridging to Learn and Ready to Learn cohorts will work towards the [ASDAN Life Skills Challenge](#). This is again a bespoke certificated programme that we have linked to their Core Skills academic learning. Students will work towards a variety of units, relative to their start points, with the aim of supporting the development of their literacy and numeracy skills.

At Key Stage Five (Years 12 to 14) our Bridging to Learn and Ready to Learn cohorts will embark on a variety of formal assessments, relative to their academic start points, predicted outcomes and aspirations.
