- **One parent per family** to drop off/ collect
- Please do stick to your drop off and collection time, it will ensure that there's a steady flow of people on site to avoid unnecessary crowding.
- For collection, the gates will be open at 14:55. Parents are asked not to arrive before 14:55 as this would result in congestion. To support the safe environment, **parents must adhere** to the collection and drop off times.

- On PE days, children can come into school in their **school PE kits**. The PE timetable is below. Those in **RED** indicate changes to the previous timetable.





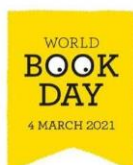
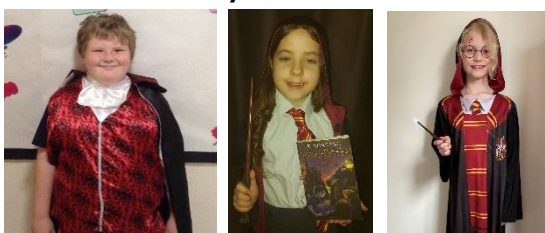
