

Class 4 Summer 1 Half-term Homework Project

As part of our Science learning this term, the children's homework project is to research and present their findings about two significant scientists:

JANE GOODALL or **DAVID ATTENBOROUGH**.

You can use websites and library books to help you! **It should ALL be your own work!** (Do not copy and paste!) Each week there is a new task for you to complete to help spread the project out. I also have tried to include a variety of tasks that link to the curriculum so there should be something for everyone.

The project should be handed in on Monday 17th May 2021.

There will be 1st, 2nd and 3rd place prizes as well as some projects being marked highly commended, there will be a prize for everyone who presents a project. Projects will be judged on effort, presentation, content and consistency.



Week One (w/b 13th April) (ART link)

Choose at least 1 task:

- 1) Design a front cover on A4 paper.
Remember to include your name, title, some pictures/diagrams and relating words..
- 2) Create a portrait of your chosen scientist.
You can choose the medium – pencil, paint, pastel etc.

Week Two (w/b 19th April) (ENGLISH link)

Choose at least 2 tasks:

- 1) Create a fact file about your chosen scientist on A4 paper.
Things to include: Date of birth, place of birth, their upbringing (education etc.), why are they famous?, places they have visited, fun facts. You need to include at least ten facts. Use a variety of presentation features (text boxes, bullet points, did you know? etc.) Remember it must be your own words, not just copied and pasted from your source.
- 2) Create a Wordle about your chosen scientist.
- 3) Create a quiz about your scientist
This could be multiple choice, or true or false etc.
- 4) Create a word search using words relating to your chosen scientist.
- 5) Create a crossword about your chosen scientist.

Week Three (w/b 26th April) (GEOGRAPHY link)

Choose at least 1 task:

- 1) Create a map of the significant places in your scientist's life (this could be UK or global)
- 2) Create a map showing Jane Goodall's Root & Shoot countries.

- 3) Create a map showing countries that David Attenborough has worked in.

Week Four (w/b 3rd May) (SCIENCE, ENGLISH & ART link)

Choose at least 1 task:

- 1) Write a description of a chimpanzee's habitat (Jane Goodall)
- 2) Write a description of the desert, ocean, or rainforest habitat (David Attenborough)
- 3) Create a diagram of the habitat linking with your scientist.

Week Five (w/b 10th May) (HISTORY link)

Create a timeline with significant events from your scientist's life.
