Dear Parents and Carers,

As discussed with the children, the recommended kit list for the Grafham Water Centre taster day on **Tuesday 14th September** is as follows:

WEAR – OLD CLOTHES

- Warm trousers (NOT denim/jeans) or cool trousers!
- Sweater/fleece
- T-shirt
- Outdoor shoes (e.g. old trainers) for wet/muddy activities. Do NOT wear any favourite or precious clothes
- Gloves & hat & waterproof coat/ jacket/anorak/ sun-cream (depending on the weather)
- Shoulder length hair tied back for the day (plaits, ponies etc.); it helps to keep the mud out!

BRING -

- A tasty packed lunch - finger foods are best - and a snack and a water bottle (no fizzy drinks and/or cans)
- A complete change of clothes including undies and footwear - in some activities, clothes may get wet and muddy, so please provide a full change of clothes and footwear for the journey home.
- A bin bag for wet clothes.
- An old towel.
- A swimming costume/swimming shorts.
- A pair of water shoes – or shoes that you can wear in the water! NOT flip-flops, crocs, or wellies.
- A book or card game for the journey (Please do not bring any electrical items, including cameras)

Think about:

- Warmth
- Dryness
- Ease of carrying
- Ease of clothing identification – name everything please!
- Medication
- If you need spectacles, a spectacle safe headband is advisable but not essential.
