Growing season has started in earnest in Nursery. In our garden area we have perennials nearly ready to flower, herbs to add to the sensory experience as well as potatoes and strawberries. The children take great care in the garden with everything being watered thoroughly!

Inside we have a plant station where we are taking care of tomato plants and marigolds. This week we also planted some magic beans! We are not sure where they have come from so we are extremely excited about what they might grow into.
