How to make smoothie ice lollies



Ingredients

- 1 large banana, or 2 small bananas
- 300 g frozen mixed berries
- 50 g porridge oats
- 400 ml pure organic apple juice

Instructions.

Place the bananas, berries, oats and apple juice in a liquidizer. Blitz for a few minutes until the berries and banana are completely smooth and the porridge oats are whizzed up. Taste for sweetness. Divide the smoothie mixture into 12 ice-lolly moulds and freeze for at least 2 hours.
