IMPACT

<p>FUNDING: £8205</p> <p>PE teacher (1yr fixed term contract of 3.5hrs per week), employed to support and develop teaching & Learning of PE.</p> <p>Objectives:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In the Autumn term, audit pupils' understanding and skills in the different disciplines of PE and compare results in the Summer term. • Audit Staffs' skills in PE teaching before and after CPD. • Identify areas for development in PE provision and target with training and external provision e.g. Gymnastic teaching & learning. • Provide a training programme for staff that is on-going within lessons and is adapted to the needs of the school. • Introducing and running the Playmakers programme at Lunchtimes. • Provide an After School Club on priorities from the audits. E.g. Gymnastics. <p>Set up whole school PE assessments and provide evidence to support judgements</p>
<p>IMPACT:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CPD for staff on teaching Gymnastics – lesson observations displayed good progressional skills across the school with elements of outstanding practice. Confidence of staff was evident within observations. • Pupils demonstrated a better understanding of subject vocabulary and skills in PE in lesson observations. Outcomes of lessons highlighted structure with warm up and cool down exercises and time to recall knowledge on newfound skills. • Playmakers are run by children and sessions are planned and organised by the volunteers for the rest of the school to take part in at lunchtimes. • Gymnastics club further promotes gymnastic skills across KS2. • PE assessment system enables teachers to accurately level and record children's attainment within the subject. <p>COST:£5160</p>
<p>HLTA provides extra provision at lunchtimes to encourage 'Change for Life' programme. 2 x ½ hr sessions per week. E.g. Cross Country and netball etc.</p> <p>Objectives:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Targets pupils who need encouragement to take part in sporting activities • Develops children's self- esteem • Encourages active participation • Develops a better understanding of 'living healthily'.
<p>IMPACT:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Uptake of children wanting to partake in regular exercise and sporting activities increased by 20% over all the activities. <p>COST:£585</p>
<p>Engage the school into the Playermakers scheme. The scheme provides a basis for children to take ownership of playtime provision by developing their leadership, promoting social and team building skills. Objectives:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pupils are confident in providing playground games that promote fitness and team building opportunities. • Provision is increased by the variety of activities provided at break / lunch times • Peer coaching • Pupils gain fundamental skills in leadership, social and team building.
<p>IMPACT:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children displayed good leadership skills in organising and running the sessions for all children to partake. • Children's engagement increased depending on certain activities e.g. competitive races etc. <p>COST:£46 Playmakers subscription</p>

<p>Travel expenses for cluster and external sports competitions / events</p> <p>IMPACT:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enabled children to partake in a wide range of competitions and events associated with sport or health / emotional well being <p>COST: £200</p>
<p>The school has bought into the Cheltenham & North Tewkesbury School Sport Network.</p> <p>This provides the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 day bespoke package which may include whole staff INSET, development of curriculum, assessment or monitoring etc. • Cluster Competitions • CPD for staff 6 termly courses • G&T / SEND holiday camps (for 2 of our students) • Dance festival, Olympic multi-skills day, Tag Rugby Festival, Athletics etc. • 12x 1hr coaching sessions <p>Preparation for Ofsted</p>
<p>IMPACT:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Good quality training for staff in school priorities – targeted all teaching staff in Netball, Dance, Gymnastics and Ofsted requirements. • Enabled our small school to partake in competitions against larger schools • Provided G&T provision for 2 children of the school • Provided good quality coaching for children in Rugby skills. <p>COST: £750</p>
<p>The school supplements After School Sports provision provided by an external provider. The provision runs alongside teacher clubs, ensuring variety and choice for children in the different keystages.</p> <p>Objectives:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provides a range of sporting activities for all pupils • Expertise in certain sport disciplines • Seasonal sports are provided <p>Targets all keystages</p>
<p>IMPACT:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provided the children with 5 different sporting activities as after school clubs over a week. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Dance, Cricket, Athletics, Multiskills & Rounders – supported by funding. <p>COST: £300</p>
<p>Signed up to the Golden Mile to encourage children to be active by exercising a mile at a time.</p> <p>Objectives:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Highlights the benefits of daily exercise to pupils • Engages all children & staff regardless of skills <p>Parental engagement</p>
<p>IMPACT:</p> <p>ONGOING</p> <p>COST: £70</p>
<p>Equipment / resources purchased to supplement existing resources or provide new equipment for the provision of sport.</p>
<p>IMPACT:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Better PE resources for children to use within lessons • Purchase of unusual PE equipment e.g. space hoppers etc. <p>COST: £250</p>
