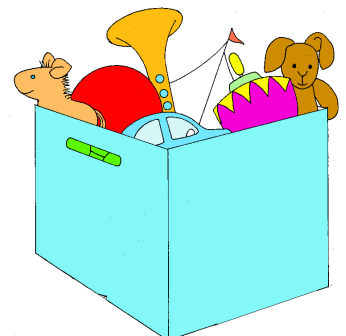

- Balloon Cars •Air rockets

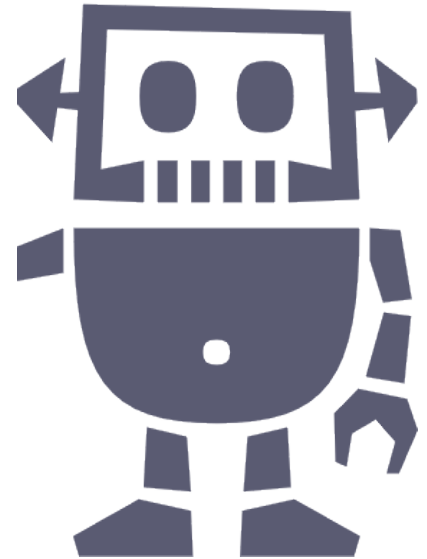
