Write the story or if you want, create a little booklet that tells the story with illustrations.</p> 	<p><u>Read all about it!</u></p> <p>Imagine that astronauts have landed on one of the planets in our solar system. Write the newspaper report!</p>
<p><u>Poem</u></p> <p>Make an acrostic for one of the planets e.g. M A R S</p> <p>This could be a list of words beginning with each letter, a sentence for each line or even a rhyme.</p>	<p><u>RE – Bible challenge</u></p> <p>Use a Bible or the internet for this task. If you use the internet, 'Bible Gateway' is a great site to use because you can see different versions of the Bible. Either write or draw them in your suitcase.
