What is Welcome Time?	Children are encouraged to find their name and add it to their self- registration photograph/ to have a go at writing their name/ to find a friend/ to share a story or choose an activity in the environment.
What is Explorer Time?	<p>Children are supported and encouraged to learn through play while accessing planned and, in the moment learning opportunities. These opportunities are steered by the children’s interests and the early years framework. They support the children’s age and stage of development and provide challenges for learning. Children are continuously observed and extended by all nursery staff.</p> <p>Children are able to access a wide range of resources and activities that support the development of the 7 areas of learning: Communication and Language, PSED Development, Physical Development, Literacy. Math’s, Understanding of the World and Expressive Arts and Design.</p>
