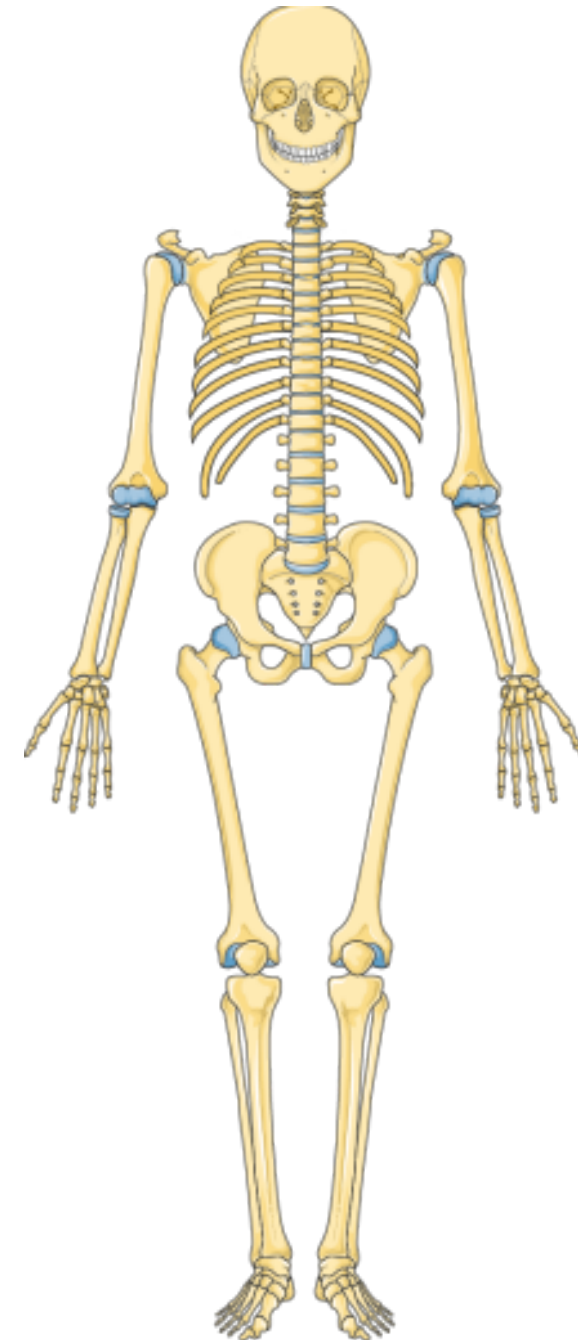
From this we will be writing a postcard from an animal's point of view, and then an animal fact file.
