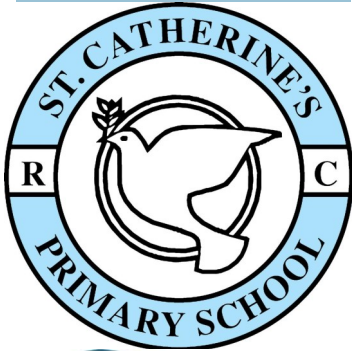

Feeling Safe Questionnaire

At the end of last half term we surveyed all the children to get their views on life in school. We asked a series of 10 questions and here are their responses in percentages. The areas highlighted in green show an improvement since the last survey taken in December 2016. The areas in white have dipped slightly (by no more than 2%) We use the survey to identify areas for improvement, so our school council will be discussing ways in which we can make changes to ensure all our boys and girls are enjoying their playtime, and know what to do if they feel sad or are hurt in any way.

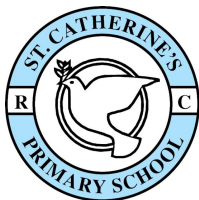
