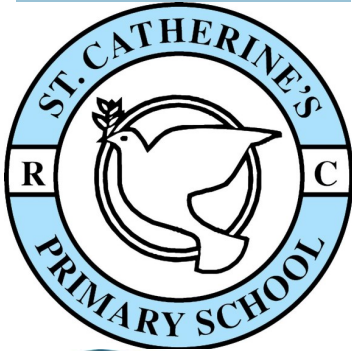

Absences

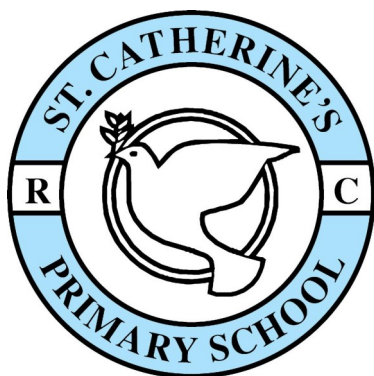
