

Year 3 Curriculum Overview



English

Reading

- To prepare poems to read aloud and to perform, showing understanding through intonation, tone, volume and action
- To identifying main ideas drawn from more than one paragraph and summarising these
- To retrieve and record information from non-fiction

Writing

- To compose and rehearse sentences orally (including dialogue), progressively building a varied and rich vocabulary and an increasing range of sentence structures.
- To organise paragraphs around a theme.
- To propose changes to grammar and vocabulary

Grammar and Spelling

- To indicating possession by using the possessive apostrophe with singular and plural noun.
- To understand common word families, showing how words are related in form and meaning [e.g. solve, solution, solver, dissolve, insoluble].
- To use a wider range of conjunctions, e.g. *when, if, because, although*

Art & Design

Computing

- design and write programs that accomplish specific goals
- use sequence, selection, and repetition in programs
- explain how a set of instructions work and to detect and correct errors in ..

Mathematics

- To multiply and divide using formal written methods
- solve problems, including missing number problems, using number facts, place value, and more complex multiplication and division
- To recognise equivalent fractions
- To add and subtract fractions of the same denominator
- To tell and write the time from an analogue clock, including using Roman numerals from I to XII, and 12-hour and 24-hour clocks.
- To measure, compare, add and subtract: lengths (m/cm/mm); mass (kg/g)
- To solve problems involving measure
- To measure perimeter of 2D shapes

- name and locate counties and cities of the United Kingdom
- use maps, atlases
- describe and understand volcanoes

- explore light
- notice that light is reflected from surfaces
- find patterns that determine the size of shadows.
