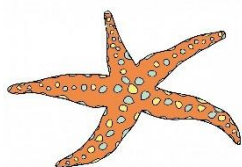
UN WORLD PEACE DAY

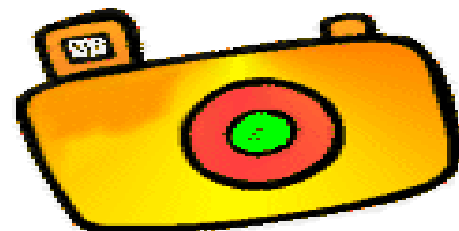


CONSENT FORMS

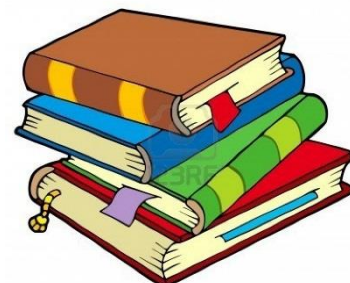
TREVIGLAS TRANSITION ORCHESTRA
