No extra-curricular clubs **NEXT WEEK.**

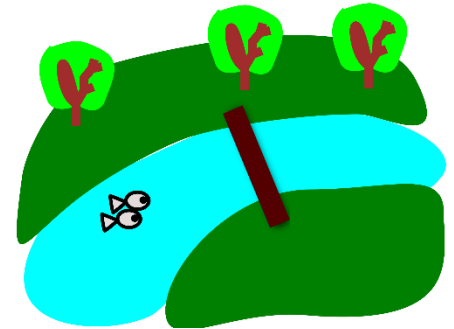
The new list of Clubs will be sent out next week. Clubs will start **MON 16<sup>th</sup> APRIL.**

Some great outfits today! Thank you so much for your donations. We will let you know how much we have raised in the next newsletter.

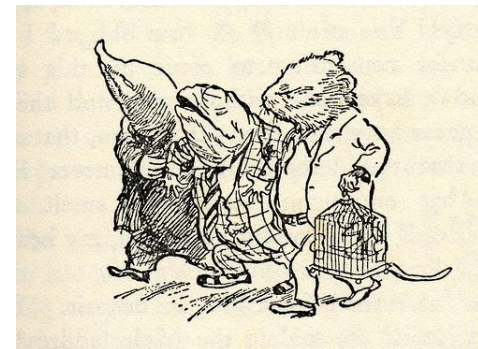


### **WORLD BOOK DAY**

## PARENTPAY - OUR NEW ON-LINE PAYMENT SERVICE

Your account activation details will be sent home soon. Just follow the instructions in the letter to get started with ParentPay. We will be launching ParentPay on **THURSDAY 12<sup>th</sup> APRIL**.

Please can we ask that all outstanding payments are made to the school by **TUESDAY 27<sup>th</sup> MARCH** so we can start the new term with NO debts (the only exception being school camp).

### Making a payment

You will be able to add money to your account from **THURSDAY 12<sup>th</sup> APRIL**. Please do not access your account until this date as we will be working on your account over the holiday period.

### Lunches

From 16<sup>th</sup> APRIL, ALL children across the school will be required to select their meal option EVERY morning on the new ParentPay system in class. For children in Year 3, 4, 5, 6, when they select a school meal or jacket potato option, this will be charged automatically to your ParentPay account. For Year R, 1 & 2 Free School Meals still apply.

### After School Club and Morning Club

After Easter, both After School Club and Morning Club will no longer be taking cash. Please book the sessions you require on-line through ParentPay. In emergencies, you may phone the office to book your child into After School Club and we will add this payment to your account on-line.

### Uniform

Uniform can be paid for on-line and you can collect the size you require from the school office.

### School Camps

Your outstanding balances will be added to your ParentPay account over the Easter break. You will then be able to make payments against your balance until the due dates.
