CHRISTMAS MARKET

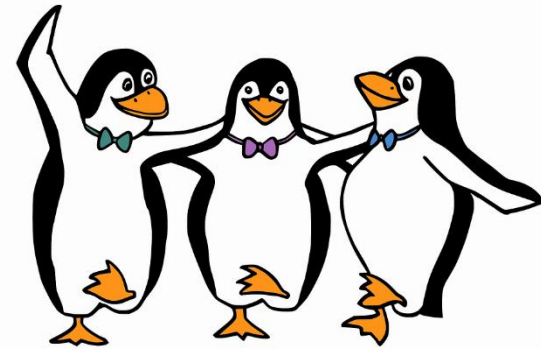

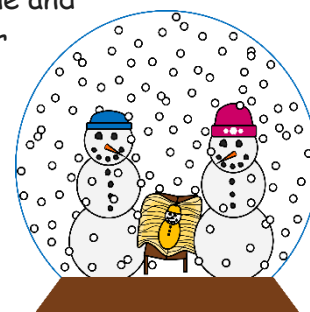
