### ROAD SAFETY

Thank you to all the parents and friends who have signed the petition calling for speed measures in Mount Hawke. We are all so aware of how congested the village gets at peak times, and how fast some people drive, leading to some near misses. On Wednesday, members of the Parish Council, representatives from Cornwall Council and local residents all met to discuss how we can improve both traffic flow and road safety. As part of this, we will be looking at the possibility of a walking bus and supporting the installation of speed aware signs. We would also ask for your support.

What can we all do to help?

Drive at low speeds through the village, with great awareness of other road users and, if possible, walk to school. We encourage the use of Rodda's Road as a walking road at drop off and pick up times, so please try not to drive down it or park in it. If you can park away from school and walk/scoot/cycle the last bit, it would really help...help the environment, help road safety and help children's learning. For children living further away, there are school buses.

Fitting into this very nicely is Walk to School Week. This runs from 20th-24th May 2019. It's a special one this year because it coincides with the 90th Anniversary of Living Streets, the UK charity for everyday walking. <https://www.livingstreets.org.uk/walk-to-school/primary-schools>
