PARENT CONSULTATION APPOINTMENTS

Parent consultation appointments are now available to book through your eSchools App or the eSchools website.



If you need to alter an appointment, please contact the office as the App doesn't allow you to delete appointments once they are in place. Please also remember that it is one appointment for each family. If your child gets taught by two different teachers through the week, please only make an appointment with one of those teachers.

SICKNESS & THE 48 HOUR RULE

There have been the inevitable coughs, colds and other germs too and we would like to remind you all that any child in the school who is sick, or has diarrhoea, must remain off school for ***48 hours** after their last bout of illness to help us stop the spread of germs.

REGULAR HAIR CHECKS / HEAD LICE

We have been notified by several parents that they are treating their children's hair for head lice. Please check your child's head weekly and take the necessary action, or seek medical advice, if you find any traces. We encourage any children with longer hair to keep it tied back, in line with our uniform policy. Several parents have suggested having two days marked on your calendar at home, whereby you check your child's hair on those days every week. In this way, we will all be aware if a problem arises and can take the necessary evasive action.

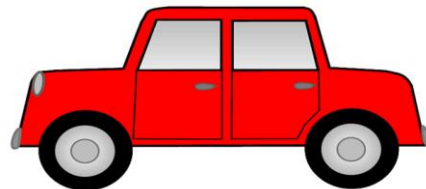
