### SATs Week


We would like to wish all of our children good luck that are taking part in SATs this week, we know you will all be fantastic.

### Headlice

We have had another confirmed case of headlice again in school. Please can we ask all parents/guardians to check their child/children's hair on a regular basis and treat appropriately. Should anyone need an another nit comb please see Mrs Jilbert. Additionally, should anyone have any concerns about headlice or would like some more advice, please do speak to any member of staff. We are all here to help to get on top of this recurring problem.

### Chickenpox

We have had a few confirmed cases of children with chickenpox.

Chickenpox is common and mostly affects children, although you can get it at any age. It usually gets better by itself within a week without needing to see a GP. Chickenpox is infectious from 2 days before the spots appear to until they've crusted over, usually 5 days after they first appeared. Therefore, if you do suspect that your child may have chickenpox, we kindly ask that you keep them off school until their scabs have completed healed over.

Should anyone wish to have any further information regarding chickenpox, please do not hesitate to ask a member of staff and we will print off the NHS guidance for you.

### School Uniform

We have now moved over to Tesco F&F Clothing as providers for our school uniform. This means that parents/guardians can order direct through them for their child's school uniform or Cubs uniform.
