Healthy me

 <p>English</p>	<p>The children will read, discuss and recite nature poems. The children will study sentence punctuation including questions & answers, and adjectives. The children will learn how to build descriptive vocabulary and use senses to write poems.</p>
 <p>Maths</p>	<p>Every term the children will cover a variety of Maths objectives related to five main areas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Counting, partitioning and calculating• Securing number facts and understanding shape• Handling data and measures• Calculating and measuring• Reasoning and applying mathematical ideas.
 <p>Science</p>	<p>In this unit children have the opportunity to closely study plants and trees in the natural environment, taking measurements and making observational drawings. Children plant a seed and a bulb and compare them as they grow. They record changes in their plants in words and pictures, take measurements throughout the unit and finally draw bar charts to show the growth of the two plants. Children set up a comparative experiment to observe what plants need to grow well, and watch the germination process first hand by growing cress. Children begin to learn about plants we eat, and understand that farming involves creating the right conditions for food crops to grow.</p>



Geography

In this lively and fun topic, children will use observational skills as they study the geography of their school, the grounds and the key human and physical features of the surrounding environment. During the final weeks, we will be comparing our local area knowledge with a small area in Kenya.



Art

This Dips and Dippers unit will teach your class about good food hygiene rules and using kitchen equipment to prepare food safely. Children will apply these skills when making and evaluating a healthy dip and dippers. The unit develops children's understanding of the eatwell plate and explains the importance of eating a healthy and varied diet.



ICT

We are continuing our Word Processing Skills unit which will teach basic typing and word processing skills. Children will learn how to type with two hands, use the shift, space and enter key properly, and edit work by using the backspace, delete and arrow keys. Children will then go on to learn how to use undo and redo and to select and format text.



Music

This unit, we will learn a collection of songs and complete music activities linking to the traditional story of *Jack and the Beanstalk*. The songs, together with the story episodes, tell the adventures of Jack and his encounters with the Giant at the top of the beanstalk. The children will be focusing on these music skills:

- breathing, posture, articulation, sound projection
 - high/low/different paces/timbre/texture
- structure (phrase, chorus, verse)
 - context (venue, occasion, time and place, intended effect) • singing songs in unison, with clear diction, control of pitch,
- a sense of phrase and musical expression
 - call and response
 - practising, rehearsing and presenting performances with
- an awareness of the audience
 - listening with attention to detail and recalling sounds with increasing aural memory
 - rehearsal and performance tips.



PSHE

During this half term, children will be looking at healthy lifestyles, including the importance of exercise, healthy eating and hygiene including dental hygiene. These healthy living lessons develop our investigation skills by investigating the impact of sugar on our teeth, the impact of exercise on our bodies and how handwashing is essential for good hygiene.



Homework

Children are expected:

- To read at least four times a week.
- To practice their number bond/fact weekly as they have their 99 Club every Friday.
- To practice their weekly spellings; set on a Friday and tested on Fridays (spellings are sent home on Fridays)
- To regularly log on and use Reading eggs at home.
