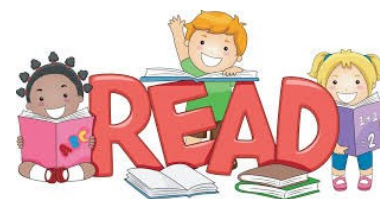
New Sports Equipment

The ultimate challenge is to complete all 99 questions of the 99 Club unaided, with no errors and within five minutes!

Sheets are available to download below for pupils to practise their level at home (see the icon on the 99 Club homepage). You can support your child by finding out which level they are working at and helping them to practise the relevant times tables. The aim is to improve basic number skills, the more rapid the recall; the better!
